Each application submitted by the deadline will be read by the members of the Collegiate Committee, USAC National Coordinators and members of USAC staff and graded according to the following rubric on a scale of 100 points.

Resume – 20 points

Format/Appearance	5 Points
Grammar/Spelling	5 Points
Content	10 Points

Essay – 80 Points

Format/Appearance	5 Points
Grammar/Spelling	5 Points
Question 1 – What does collegiate climbing mean to you?	10 Points
Question 2 – What impact has climbing had on your collegiate experience?	15 Points
Question 3 – What are you doing to help grow collegiate climbing?	15 Points
Question 4 – How have you given back to your local climbing community?	15 Points
Question 5 – What part of being in the collegiate climbing community do you find most rewarding?	15 Points

Each question will be awarded a point value based on the thoroughness and content of the answer.
