Competitor Check-In:

All Competitors must check-in during their respective check-in times as outlined on the schedule.

Competitors will receive their competition bibs at check-in and are required to wear them such that they are visible in the middle of their back throughout the competition.

Bibs must be kept through all rounds of competition.

Prior to the competition all competitors must complete a gym waiver for Sportrock Climbing Center.

Competition Format:

Lead Qualification Format will be flash format and organized according the NACS Event Manual *(linked <u>HERE</u>)*. Route demonstration videos shall be made available no later than 2 hours prior to the start of the qualification round.

Lead Semi-Finals and Finals will be onsite format and organized according to the NACS Event Manual (*linked* <u>HERE</u>).

Speed Qualification will be a Valid Time Format and organized according to the NACS Event Manual (*linked* <u>HERE</u>).

Speed Finals will be a Knockout Format and organized according to the NACS Event Manual (*linked* <u>HERE</u>).

Coach Registration & Check-In:

All USA Climbing Coaches at the 2023 NACS Lead/Speed Sportrock Climbing Cetner must have a Current Certified Coach membership.

National Federations may register any number of Team Officials (*Team Managers, coaches, or qualified medical/para-medical personnel*) through their respective National Federation according to the registration procedures.

Coaches will be required to register for the "2023 NACS Lead/Speed – Sportrock Climbing Center Coaches Registration" event in advance.

- The free registration will open in conjunction with the competitor registration and can be found by logging in to your USA Climbing account under "Events".

- Coaches will be required to scan their electronic or PDF membership card upon check in at the event.

- Coaches will be required to verify their ID with a valid photo ID during check-in.

- Membership cards can be found in the membership confirmation email. The PDF card can be printed, or the electronic card can be downloaded to your smartphone. Instructions can be found in your membership confirmation email. To access your membership confirmation email, please log in to your USA Climbing account, click on the

"Memberships" tab/ "Current"/ "Resend Membership Email". Prior to the competition all coaches must complete a gym waiver for <u>Sportrock</u>

Climbing Center.

Coaches must have a qualified competitor in the round to be admitted into isolation.

Results:

Results can be viewed during all rounds of competition on the <u>USA Climbing</u> <u>Results Website</u> and will be marked "official" there following each round of competition.

Further information on the appeals process will be provided to competitors and coaches during the Technical Meeting.

Lead Ropes:

USA Climbing will provide lead ropes for the competition, however, competitors may provide their own climbing rope, where the rope diameter must be between 9.5mm to 10.1mm, a minimum of 45m, and meet any additional requirements as set forth for the specific event.

If a competitor is using their own rope, they must bring the rope to their first climb properly flaked into an IKEA bag and prepared for climbing.

IKEA bags will be available at check in if needed.

If a competitor's rope is not properly flaked and prepared for climbing, an event rope will be used.

If the rope does not meet the requirements stated above, the rope may be denied at the discretion of the head belayer. In this case, competitor must use the ropes provided by USA Climbing for the event.

Event Parking & Spectating:

Each athlete's bib will serve as their spectating ticket for all disciplines during the event.

The Lead Qualification & Speed Qualification/Finals rounds (*Friday, September 22nd & Sunday, September 24th*) will not require tickets.

The Lead Semi-Finals/Finals rounds (*Saturday, September 23rd*) will require tickets and will grant day access to spectating.

The ticket link may be found at the <u>2023 NACS Lead/Speed – Sportrock Eventbrite</u> Lead Semi-Final/Final day tickets will be \$15.

All spectators will be required to complete a gym waiver for <u>Sportrock Climbing</u> <u>Center</u> prior to being admitted into the facility.
