

### 3.1 Merida.

 Mérida is the capital of the state of Yucatán in southeastern Mexico. It is located on the Yucatán Peninsula, about 35 kilometers (22 miles) inland from the Gulf of Mexico. The city is known for its rich Mayan and colonial history, vibrant culture, and architecture, as well as its proximity to important archaeological sites such as Chichén Itzá and Uxmal, besides this, close to Merdida there is a place for Piscobloc!.

 The Mérida International Airport (Manuel Crescencio Rejón) receives both domestic and international flights.
