



Anti-Doping Policy

In the event that WADA, IFSC, USADA or any other anti-doping organization with jurisdiction over the athlete, coach, athlete support personnel, or other person issues a determination of an anti-doping violation, USA Climbing shall enforce the sanction imposed by such determination. USA Climbing shall ensure that such athlete, coach, athlete support personnel, or other person has been adequately notified of such determination and the process, and that the terms and conditions of the sanction are enforced at all levels under the jurisdiction of USA Climbing in accordance with the sanction.

I acknowledge that it is the duty of each USA Climbing member to comply with all anti-doping rules of the IFSC, World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), and of the U.S. Anti-Doping Agency (USADA), including the USADA Protocol for Olympic and Paralympic Movement Testing (USADA Protocol) and all other policies and rules adopted by the IFSC, WADA, USADA and the United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee (USOPC). I agree to submit to drug testing by the IFSC and/or USADA or their designees at any time and understand that the use of methods or substances prohibited by the applicable anti-doping rules make me subject to penalties including, but not limited to, disqualification and suspension. If it is determined that I may have committed a doping violation, I agree to submit to the results management authority and processes of USADA, including arbitration under the USADA Protocol, or to the results management authority of the IFSC and/or USA Climbing, if applicable or referred by USADA.
