Registration will open Wednesday, June 25th, 2025, at 12:00pm (*Noon*) MT and will close Thursday, August 21st, 2025, at 12:00pm (*Noon*) MT.

The entry fee will increase two times: at midnight at the end of Wednesday, August 6th, 2025, and at the end of Tuesday, August 12th, 2025, both MT.

Each competitor is responsible for ensuring they are registered for the correct discipline(s) prior to the closure of any registration deadline(s) by verifying against their confirmation email and/or against the Public Event Registrant List.

Competitor Check-In

All Competitors must check-in during their respective check-in times as outlined on the schedule.







Competitors will receive their competition bibs at check-in for each discipline(s) and will be expected to wear them in the middle of their back throughout the competition.

Bibs must be kept through all rounds of competition.

Coach Registration & Check-In | Coach Registration

All Coaches at the 2025 NACS Salt Lake City, UT (Lead | Speed) must have a Current Certified Coach membership.

Coaches will be required to register for the "2025 NACS Salt Lake City, UT (*Lead | Speed*) Coaches Registration" event prior to checking in.

- Coaches will be required to scan their electronic or PDF membership card upon check in at the event.

Prize Money

There will be \$2.5 cash prize per, discipline per gender for the adult categories in the 2025 NACS Salt Lake City, UT (*Lead* | *Speed*) event. Prize money will not be allocated to the U-17 Youth categories.

Winners will be required to complete and submit a W-9 to USA Climbing before prize money can be issued.
